§1-101                    Article 1. General Provisions

**§1-101 GENERAL PROVISIONS; CORPORATE EXISTENCE.** The City of Crete, Nebraska is hereby found and declared to be a City of more than five thousand (5,000) persons. The Municipality shall be governed by the laws of Nebraska regulating Cities of the First Class. (*Ref. 16-101 RS Neb.*)

**§1-102 GENERAL PROVISIONS; SERVICE OF PROCESS.** All process affecting the Municipality may be served by personal, residence, or certified mail service upon the Chief Executive Official or the Clerk. (*Ref. 16-115, 25-510.02(2) RS Neb.*)

**§1-103 GENERAL PROVISIONS; POWERS.** The Municipality is a body corporate and politic. It shall have the power to sue and be sued; to purchase, lease, lease with option to buy or acquire by gift or devise, and to hold real and personal property within or without the corporate limits of the Municipality, and real estate sold for taxes for the use of the Municipality in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as may be deemed in the best interests of the Municipality; and to exercise such other and further powers as may be conferred by law. (*Ref. 16-201 RS Neb.*)

**§1-104 GENERAL PROVISIONS-CODIFICATION OF ORDINANCES.** The Municipality shall have the power to revise the ordinances of the Municipality from time to time and publish the same in book form. The revision shall be evidenced by a general codification ordinance which shall embrace all ordinances preserved as changed or added to and perfected by revision and shall embrace all the ordinances of every nature preserved, and be a repeal of all ordinances in conflict with such revision. All ordinances in force at the time of the codification shall continue in force for the purpose of all rights acquired, fines, penalties, forfeitures, and liabilities incurred. Accordance with the term and conditions of the Nebraska General Emergency Succession Act, the Governing Body hereby declares that it is necessary and advisable to invoke the provisions of the said Act in the Municipality. **§1-105      GENERAL PROVISIONS; EMERGENCY SUCCESSION ACT.** In accordance with the term and conditions of the Nebraska General Emergency Succession Act, the Governing Body hereby declares that it is necessary and advisable to invoke the provisions of the said Act in the Municipality.
