## CHAPTER 2 COMMISSIONS AND BOARDS

## Article 1. Standing Committees

**§2-101 STANDING COMMITTEES.** The Mayor, with the approval of the City Council, will appoint the following Standing Committees:

- Finance Committee Park & Recreation Committee
- Personnel Committee Public Safety Committee
- Public Works Committee
- Legislative Community Development Committee

and such other Standing Committees as the City Council may by ordinance or resolution thereafter create. Each Committee shall consist of not more than three (3) members, and the personnel thereof may be changed by the Mayor at any time, with the approval of the City Council. Provided, the Mayor shall be an ex-officio member of each Standing Committee, and the first (1st) named Councilmember for each Committee shall be the chairperson. (Amended by Ord. 1440, 01/05/99)

## §2-101.01 CIVIC CENTER STANDING COMMITTEE AND ADVISORY BOARD.

- (1) The Mayor, with the approval of the City Council, will appoint a Civic Center Standing Committee, for the City of Crete Civic Center, located at 515 E. 1st Street, Crete, Nebraska. The Committee shall consist of three (3) members of the City Council, whose members shall be one (1) each from the Council Finance Committee, Council Park & Recreation Committee, and Council Public Works Committee and the Committee shall have the duty and authority to promote and control activities of the Civic Center.
- (2) A Civic Center Advisory Board is hereby created to meet with and/ or assist the Mayor, City Council and/ or the Civic Center Standing Committee of the City Council, to consult with and/ or advise the City as to matters concerning the Civic Center and the Civic Center activities. The Board shall consist of five (5) members who shall be appointed by the Mayor, by and with the approval of a majority vote of the City Council. The members or the Board shall be residents of the City. (Ord. 1763; 07/20/10)

## §2-102 COMMISSION AND BOARDS; APPOINTED BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS; APPOINTMENT BY MAYOR; REMOVAL OF BOARD AND COMMISSION MEMBERS. The mayor, by and with the advise and consent of a majority of the City Council may appoint such board or commission members.

the City Council, may appoint such board or commission members as may be established by ordinance. Unless specific procedure for removal is provided for in ordinance establishing such board or commission, all appointed board or commission members may be removed at any time by the Mayor with the approval of the majority of the Council. All confirmation of appointments to such board or commission by the Council shall be made with the concurrence of a majority of the Council and the vote for and against shall be recorded.
