§2-601 HOSPITAL BOARD. The Mayor, by and with the consent of the City Council, shall appoint the Hospital Board. The Board shall consist of five (5) members who shall be residents of the Municipality. The members of the Board shall serve a three (3) year term of office unless reappointed. The Board shall serve without compensation and may be required, in the discretion of the Governing Body, to give a bond in a sum set by resolution of Body, and conditioned the the Governing upon faithful performance of their duties. At the time of the Board's first (1st) meeting in March of each year, the Board shall organize by selecting from among its membership a chairman, vice chairman, and secretary. It shall be the duty of the secretary to keep the full and correct minutes and records of all meetings, and to file the same with the Municipal Clerk where they shall be available for public inspection at any reasonable time. Α majority of the Board members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Special meetings may be held upon the call of the chairman, or any three (3) members of the Board. It shall be the duty of the Board to have general charge of the Municipal hospital and establish appropriate rules and regulations for the management, operation, and use of the same. All actions of the Board shall be subject to review and supervision of the Governing Body. The Board shall be such reports and performing responsible for making such additional duties as the Governing Body may from time to time designate. No member of the Governing Body shall serve as a member of the Hospital Board while serving a term of office as a member of the Governing Body. No member of the Hospital Board shall serve in the capacity of both the chairman and secretary of the Board. (Ref. 16-239 RS Neb.)
