§7-401 Article 4. Poisonous and Flammable Gases §7-401

S7-401 POISONOUS AND FLAMMABLE GASES. Any person, firm, or corporation desiring to store or keep in the Municipality for any period of time any form of poisonous flammable or anhydrous ammonia gas or liquefied petroleum gas in excess of five (5) gallons or add to, enlarge, or replace any facility used for the storage of such gases, must first get permission from the Governing Body. The Governing Body, shall require the name of the gas, the place of storage, and the amount of gas stored. If permission is granted, the Governing Body shall prescribe such rules, regulations, and precautionary, actions as they may deem necessary. Any such present use that is discontinued for a period of sixty (60) days shall not be revived without a permit. (Ref. 16-222 RS Neb.)
