## BUSINESS REGULATIONS

## §10-1101 Article 11 Hobbyist Permit §10-1101

<u>§10-1101 HOBBYIST PERMIT</u>. The Crete Police Department may issue a hobbyist permit to any owner, agent, occupant, tenant, or person in possession of, charge or control of any real property for the restoration or repair of no more than two nonoperating, partially dismantled, and unregistered vehicles for a period of no more than 180 days.

(a) <u>Application</u>. The applicant shall file an application for a hobbyist permit with the Crete Police Department on a form provided by the City. The application shall contain the name and address of the applicant and the make, model, year, location, and vehicle identification number of each vehicle to be restored or repaired.

(b) <u>Ownership</u>. The applicant shall own vehicle(s) to be restored or repaired and shall provide proof of ownership to the Crete Police Department at time of application.

(c) <u>Fee.</u> The applicant shall pay a fee of \$100 per vehicle at time of application.

(d) <u>Expiration</u>. All hobbyist permits shall expire on the 180th day following the issuance thereof.

(e) <u>Renewal.</u> If the applicant demonstrates just progress toward the restoration or repair of said vehicle(s), prior to the expiration of the hobbyist permit, to the Crete Police Department, the Department may renew the hobbyist permit, but only one time, for an additional 90 days. The applicant shall pay a fee of \$100 per vehicle at time of renewal.

(f) Limit. No individual may hold hobbyist permits) for more than two (2) vehicles and no property may contain more than two (2) vehicle(s) to be restored or repaired at any given time.

(g) <u>Nuisance.</u> Said vehicle(s) found on any property after the expiration of the hobbyist permit shall be declared a nuisance. (Ord. No. 1355, 10/1/96; Ord. No. 1626, 01/18/05)
