SWIM SUIT POLICY

- All patrons who want to swim MUST wear a commercially purchased swim suit.
- NO street clothes are allowed in the pool, including, but not limited to: jeans, gym shorts, cotton t-shirts, leggings/joggers.
- ALL infants must wear a swim-approved diaper; available for purchase at the pool.

SWIM TEAM

Crete Riptide Swim Team offers kids ages 5-19 (if still in high school) a chance to

participate in a competitive swim league with five Saturday meets in the Kansas-Nebraska Swim League. Members of the team are required to purchase their own swim suit



and goggles (not included in registration fee). Practices are held Monday-Friday, 8 - 10 a.m., Wildwood Pool. All swimmers must be able to swim the length of the pool unaided. Registration runs from April through early May.

WEATHER POLICIES

The safety and well being of all pool patrons is the the number one priority for all staff members at Crete Wildwood Pool and to ensure a safe environment, the pool has adopted the following weather policies:

Cool Temperatures

The pool will close any time the air temperature during the day is recorded below 70 degrees F.

Thunder & Lightning Safety

Wildwood Pool utilizes the WeatherBug phone application to track thunderstorms and lightning strikes in the area. The Manager on Duty is designated and responsible to monitor any potentially dangerous weather conditions including thunderstorms, lightning, thunder, and tornados.

The Manager on Duty will start monitoring

thunderstorms containing lightning when the storm is 20 miles away.

When lightning is detected within a 10-mile radius of the pool, the Manager on Duty will call for the pool to be cleared. All patrons will be asked to leave the pool deck and bathhouses and remain in the front entrance. The Manager on Duty will reopen the pool after lightning has remained outside the 10-mile radius for at least 30 minutes. Each time a lightning strike appears within the 10-mile radius, the 30-minute clock will restart.

The Manager on Duty is to be alert of audible thunder that can indicate an approaching storm. If thunder is heard, the Manager on Duty will call for the pool to be cleared for 30 minutes. Patrons may remain on the pool deck and bathhouses. Each time thunder is heard the 30-minute clock will restart. Once thunder has not been heard for 30 minutes the Manager on Duty will reopen the pool.
