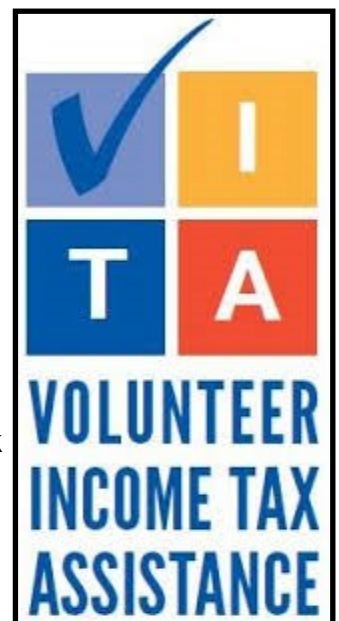
Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program available in 2021

Once again, the library is assisting Doane in providing free income tax preparation to the following community members:

- People who generally make \$57,000 or less
- Persons with disabilities; and
- Limited English-speaking taxpayers

All preparation will be done virtually. Community members will need to collect an envelope that lists all of the documentation they will need to provide in order for the Doane students to file the tax return.

These envelopes are available at the library starting February 8th – either walk in or at the pick-up window and must be returned to the library February 8th with the envelope containing the documents needed to file the tax return. These envelopes will then be collected by Doane and the tax preparation will be completed. For further information, please contact the library.
