What do four random American teens have in common? Leila.

When a seventeen-year-old girl from the south with dreams that will take her far, goes on a cross-country trip, adventures are to be expected; however, none would compare to what Leila stumbles across. This heart-wrenching novel pulls you from anger to laughter with a turn of the page.

After Hudson brings Leila a fixed car, treasure and love, an unexpected turn of events leads Leila to return to the road. She picks up a runaway hitchhiker who lives everyday for what it is. Bree shows Leila how to have fun but soon learns that fun doesn't always get you far in life. Then Leila runs into Elliot who just came from the worst night ever. Can Leila make prom night for Elliot something he will want to remember? Back on the road, having crossed the Canadian border, Leila has to backtrack to return Sonia, a runaway bridesmaid, home.
