

Sign up for Summer Reading has begun at Crete Public Library. This year we'll have programs in June <u>and</u> July! We hope children and their families will enjoy reading and participating all summer long.

Our programming will run through July so there's more time to read and participate. Registration will run through Friday, June 1. This is also the date of the kickoff event; drop in from 1 to 4 p.m. for crafts, games, a balloon artist and a visit from Elephant and Piggie.

Children registered for preschool-age programs will sign up for Wednesday or Thursday slots. Elementary-age programs will run on Tuesdays in June and include a UNL virtual field trip, Jack and Kitty music duo, a visit to Spring Creek Prairie Audubon Center, and a 4-H petting zoo. A special musical program will be held on Wednesday, June 6 for preschool and elementary ages. The pool party is scheduled for June 28.

Summer Reading programs in July will be on Wednesdays for all ages, including Pete the Cat story time, Legos & Games, a magician, and science presentation. Family Movie Night will be held on July 27 in City Park.

We also have a middle school summer reading program planned. Programs include Zen & Win, Harry Potter Movie Day, Bookmarks, Buttons & Brownies and Zombie Tag. Middle schoolers are also welcome at the pool party and the movie night.
