Nebraska State Poet Matt Mason to Visit


Nebraska State Poet, Matt Mason, will be delivering poetry at Crete Public Library! Join us on November 19 at 2 PM.

Crete Reads! 2023 Author Ellen Marie Wiseman Speaks at the Crete Public Library

The author of this year's Crete Reads! joined us via Zoom on Sunday, 22 October in the Crete Carrier Community Room. A wonderful lunch from Calabria was had for those who desired it, with cheesecake for all provided by the Friends.

Based on remarks from attendees, they thoroughly enjoyed her talk. She talked about her writing career, her writing process and research needed in order for her novels to be as historically accurate as possible. Ellen's down-to-earth manner was a breath of fresh air for such an accomplished author and this was something a number of people commented upon.

Eclipse Day at Crete Public Library

Saturday, October 14 was the date of the annular eclipse in North America, and many families in Crete were all set to (safely!) observe the spectacle from Crete Public Library. Unfortunately, the weather had other ideas, and the clouds stubbornly refused to part in time for the eclipse. Still, there was a great turn-out and kids were able to take part and enjoy a number of eclipserelated games and activities. The kids tested their astronomy knowledge (Which is hotter, the temperature of Earth's core or the surface of the Sun?), listened to the story of Shadow Bear and experimented with making shadows, bowled down spaceinvaders and colored a rocket playhouse. Outside, in the dripping rain, they tried to see how high they could launch stomp-rockets. They also took part in a couple of citizen science experiments, gathering data on the clouds and the temperature at the time of the eclipse.



The library had received a solar science kit and bi-lingual materials from NASA@ My Library, including solar spotters and a telescope with a special filter for viewing the sun during the eclipse. Though we weren't able to use these on the 14th, Nebraska will be in the path of another partial eclipse on April 8 of next year and we hope to make use of them at that time. The telescope will be part of astronomy programs the library is planning in the future.
