5-235 License To Remove Snow And Ice On Public Property

(1) For the purpose of this section, the words "remove snow or ice on public property" shall be deemed to be any service or system that purports to furnish or does furnish, for consideration, any snow, ice, or hard-packed snow removal services for sidewalks or other public ways located on public property or for pushing or carrying snow, ice, or hard-packed snow on or across public property. The phrase shall not include the removal of snow, ice, or hard-packed snow without consideration or remuneration or by anyone under the age of sixteen years old, whether for consideration or not.

(2) Before any person, firm, or corporation shall conduct, maintain, or solicit any snow, ice, or hard-packed snow removal services on public property, an application for a license to engage in such services shall be made in writing to the City. The application shall include information about the person, firm, or corporation and describe what, where, and how the service will be conducted.

(3) Any license issued by the City under this section shall be for a period of one year and may be revoked at any time for cause. The person, firm, or corporation operating such service in the city shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and shall maintain public liability property damage insurance in such amounts as may be required by the City. The fee for the license shall be set forth in the City's Master Fee Schedule.

(4) It is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation, either as principal or agent, to conduct, maintain, or solicit any snow, ice, or hard-packed snow removal services on public property without first obtaining a license from the City.
