

CITY OF CRETE SWIM TEAM HEAD COACH

Job Status: Hourly, Seasonal

Reports to: Parks and Recreation Director

I. GENERAL FUNCTIONS

City of Crete is a well-established team with a strong connection to the families in Crete and surrounding neighborhoods. The team fosters a competitive environment which encourages families to commit to the season competitively while fostering a fun summer experience. Must be energetic, experienced, reliable Head Coach to lead its summer swim team. Reports to the Parks and Recreation Director.

II. ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Oversee the City of Crete Parks & Recreation swim team to include: planning and leading daily swim practices, running preseason testing, leading coach staff, communicating with swim team parents, and developing individual swimmers in a competitive league.
- 2. Responsible for analyzing swim techniques and determining skill levels.
- 3. Head Coach will oversee and direct the assistant coach(es) under supervision of Parks and Recreation Director.
- 4. Participate in pool outreach and water safety education under supervision of facility water safety instructor.
- 5. Assist pool manager or Parks and Recreation staff in lifeguard conditioning and swim technique.
- 6. Using a range of activities to improve water confidence.
- 7. Recording training sessions in order to analyze strokes, techniques, and monitor progress. Setting training goals and objectives for teams as well as individual swimmers.
- 8. Teaching various swimming techniques to include: strokes, flips, kicks, body rolls, floating, and breath control.

- 9. Schedule summer swim meets in coordination with the swim league. Assist in organizing and hosting a minimum of one (1) home swim meet.
- 10. Attend all applicable meetings with the swim league and other team coaches.
- 11. Lead the swim team in all competitive swim meets. Assign and enter individual swimmers and relay teams into appropriate events at the swim meets. Manage the team roster and notify swimmers and parents of which events they will be competing in at each meet.
- 12. Effectively use the Swim Meet software to manage meet entries.
- 13. Represent the City of Crete in a positive manner with all interactions with other swim teams, families, and communities.
- 14. Season runs from late May through early July. Weeknight practices 7:00 9:00 pm. Alternate practice times TBD. Swim meets are held on Saturdays, approximately 8:00 am 3:00 pm. Travel is required to neighboring communities for away swim meets.
- 15. Ensuring the pool or training area is clean, well-maintained, and free of hazards.
- 16. Properly store equipment and ensure the general cleanliness of the pool areas that were used after practices and/or home swim meets.
- 17. Be an active participant in all working responsibilities.
- 18. Work cooperatively and communicate effectively with city personnel, swimming pool staff, team members and their families.
- 19. Answer questions and explain the pools policies and procedures to patrons.
- 20. Assist in general pool supervision (not as a lifeguard).
- 21. Other duties as assigned.

III. KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES

- 1. Ability to work effectively with people of all ages and backgrounds.
- 2. Proficient in English.
- 3. Must be at least 16 years of age.
- 4. Pool Operator, Lifeguard Instructor, Water Safety Instructor certification are encouraged.
- 5. Possess or obtain valid annual CPR Pro and First Aid certification.
- 5. Ability to interact with the public in a professional and courteous manner.
- 6. Ability to teach, communicate, and motivate youth athletes.
- 7. General knowledgeable of the pools programs, hours of operation, admission fees, and rules and policies.

IV. DESIRABLE TRAINING & EXPERIENCE

Any combination of work experience and training that allows the duties and responsibilities of this position to be achieved. Preference will be given to applicants

documenting successful experience in similar positions or with customer service experience.

V. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Minimum 1-year competitive swim coach/assistant coach experience
- 2. High school graduate required, current college student or college graduate preferred.
- 3. Must have a valid driver's license and pass drug and background tests.
- 4. Should be empathetic, patient and understand that swimmers have varying abilities. Exceptional swimming coaches are those who place performance over results and can motivate and inspire.
- 5. Strong organization and management skills.
- 6. Strong communication and interpersonal skills.

VI. WORKING CONDITIONS & PHYSICAL EFFORT

Light (Involves frequent lifting of more than 10 to 25 pounds. Work performed requires a good deal of walking or standing, and may include some sedentary work and working conditions that include moderate noise levels related to the use of office equipment or machinery. May involve exposure to varying outside temperatures.) to medium work classification (Involves frequent lifting 25 to 50 pounds at a time. A full range of medium work requires standing, walking, stooping, climbing, bending, etc. Working conditions may include exposure to extreme temperatures (> 100 F and/ or < 50 F) and moderate to loud noises related the operation of equipment or machinery.) for the majority of duties and responsibilities.
